The Loko i`a Pā`aiāu Fishpond, located in McGrew Point Navy Housing (Aiea), is a Native Hawaiian National Historic Landmark that dates back 400 years. Learn about this sacred space and help restore it by clearing invasive species, planting native species, and moving rocks to fill the pond wall.
