- What to Bring/Wear: Clothes you don't mind getting dirty, covered shoes/boots/tabis (may get wet), garden/work gloves, sunscreen, sunglasses, hat, 1ater bottle (refillable station available), mess kit for lunch (Reusable Tupperware and reusable utensils are okay).
