- Learn how watercress is grown and harvested
- Explore the farm's history and cultural significance
- See native plants and wildlife thriving through preservation efforts
- Give back through hands-on stewardship of the land

- All participants must register individually so we can plan accordingly.
- Activities include clearing and restoration work.
- **Open to military servicemembers, veterans, and family members ages 16+.**
- **Participants under 16 are not permitted to attend.**
- Parking is offsite at Pearlridge Center lot or Anna Miller's/Starbucks lot. Walk to the farm for the event.
- Limited space for the event, up to 35 people.
